

# Background

- Commute Seattle approached SDOT about funding bicycling related items
- A bicycle counter with a display met the desires of both organizations
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue protected bike lanes was chosen as the ideal location
  - High visibility downtown location
  - Site of existing temporary counter

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave PBL between Madison and Marion Streets

# Counter Facts

- Counts both directions of travel on the PBL
- Shows daily and annual bike volume
- Planned installation in early 2106
- Uses the same technology as the Fremont and Spokane counters for detection
